Read Aloud Activity Hour

Grades K - 3

Dates: Every other Wednesday starting June 2, 2010 (June 2, 16, 30; July 14, 28; August 4, 11)

Times: 11 am to 12 pm

Cost: \$2.00 per child per session

Archeology 101

Ages 10 - 12

Dates: Tuesday, July 13 to Friday, July 16, 2010 (Tues – Thurs at MCB; Friday at McNeill Ranch Site)

Times: 10 am to 12 pm

Cost: \$75.00 per child

Explore the science of archeology from shards to skulls. Lay out your dig site and discover methods of cleaning, measuring, and cataloging artifacts. Meet MCB's Mountain Men!; learn the tools of the trade and find out how early peoples lived off the land we call home. Discover Rock Art and see how early peoples passed on their stories as you help to recreate those stories from long ago. Wrap up the week with a visit to the McNeill Ranch Site located in northern Victoria County. Under the direction of MCB's volunteer avocational archeologists and researchers, participate in an active dig site. ***Parents will need to provide transportation to the site.*** Maps will be provided. Bring hats, sunscreen, and closed toe shoes. Pants are required at the site. Space is limited to 10 participants and advance registration is required.

All classes are held at the Museum of the Coastal Bend unless otherwise listed.
