August 19; 3:00 - 4:00 p.m. Aztec Tiles Using colorful dried pasta, re-create the artwork of the Aztecs on your own tile.

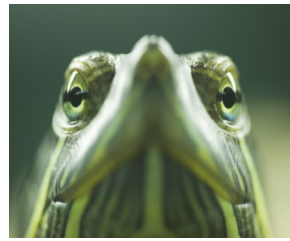

Join the museum as we work to protect our heritage! Participants will receive an introduction to the field of archeology – the importance of archeological artifacts and sites; recognizing an archeological site; recognizing traces of prehistoric sites; identifying prehistoric and historic artifacts; reporting finds; basic field methods and recording. Materials will be presented in hands-on activities, discussions, museum displays and a site visit. Jimmy Bluhm, an Archeological Steward for the Texas Historical Commission and MCB Volunteer, leads the workshop. Class limited to 15 students. Parents must provide transportation for site visit. Participants will construct ceramics similar to those created by the earliest inhabitants of the Texas Coastal Bend. Students will create earthenware and pit-fired wares using coil and pinch construction techniques and tools similar to those used by prehistoric people. Debra Chronister, instructor, is an Associate Professor of Art at The Victoria College. All supplies provided. Class limited to 8 students. Advance registration required. **Tuition: \$70 per student (non-members); \$65 per student (MCB members)**
