Activities & Lessons

Early Peoples introductory reading lesson: This is a brief overview of the daily life of the early inhabitants of the Coastal Bend region.

Megafauna Flashcards: Flashcards and corresponding information cards giving facts about the extinct megafauna from this area.

Archeology Bingo: Bingo game with enough cards for 25 students.

Bowl Weaving activity: This is a weaving exercise uses yarn and paper plates to demonstrate a common weaving technique used by the Native Americans of this region. *Teacher will need to supply materials.*

Painted Pebble activity: This activity highlights communication through pictures used by ancient people all over the world. Students will paint their own symbols onto rocks to tell their story. *Teacher will need to supply materials.*

Artifacts

There are over 30 artifacts in this traveling trunk that the students can touch and handle. A few of them are modern replicas, but most are from the past. Please ask the students to handle them with care and respect.
